Design and Expression

- *Opportunity for creative schematization*
- *Flexible Governance*
- *Accurate and timely Information*

- **Analysis of Design weak**
- **Reports on implementation ignore critical governance areas**
- **Feedback on progress inaccurate and unreliable**



Monitoring

- *Locating and detailing MDGs in more specific local contexts*
- *Inclusion of user voice*

- **Monitoring information has been unimaginative**
- **Often fails to incorporate local impediments**
- **Inadequate representation of user views**



Evaluation

- *Develop and evolve knowledge base on development process*
- *Knowledge created can provide basis for synergy across stakeholders*

- **Prefab frameworks stifle inclusion of new knowledge**
- **Focus on target attainment in preference to process elements**
- **Insular designs preclude other stakeholder inputs**
